Please note that students may be asked more than this sheet lists. The listed items are the basics for kindergarten entry, but a student may be more advanced.

Students do not need to know all of their letters and sounds in order to enter kindergarten at LCA. We like to see that students know about half of the names and sounds of the alphabet, though we have much grace here.

If your student is testing mid-year, we take the time into account. We want to see that your student is familiar with letters and numbers and on track to start kindergarten in August.
